Sherab Ling, Palampur, sacred lake Tso Pema of Guru Rinpoche, caves with yogis and yoginis. Enjoy beautiful scenery, walks, shopping for dharma objects, books, shawls, jewellery. In Dharamsala *kora* round the temple complex (the *Tsuklag-khang*) of HH Dalai Lama – AND most probably have the blessing of a brief private audience with the most famous Buddhist in the world.
